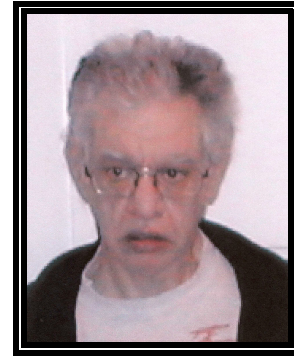


# Obituary

David John Bishop, 55, of Blackfoot, died, March 27, 2010 at his home from esophageal cancer.
