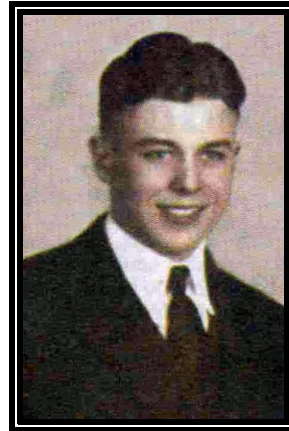


## Obituary

### Clyde Henry Bowles, 92



Clyde Henry Bowles, 92, of Yucaipa, California passed away Monday, April 5, 2010 at his home.

Clyde was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, where he served faithfully in the San Diego Temple. Clyde and Verda served a mission together at the Carthage Jail in Carthage, Illinois.

Clyde is survived by his children, Sharla Ann, Garth and Greg; sister, Betty; 12 grandchildren, 37 great grandchildren and 2 great great grandchildren (with one the way).
