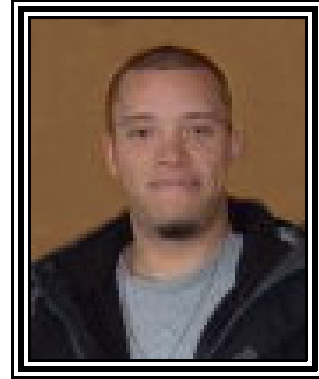


## Obituary
