Danny Junior Eagle, 58, of Pocatello, Idaho passed away Saturday, June 25, 2011 at the Portneuf Care and Rehabilitation Center in Pocatello.

Danny was born November 9, 1952 in Pocatello, to Ella Sambo and Paul Eagle, of Fort Hall. Later in childhood he was adopted by Homer and Nell Cutler of Ross Fork Creek.

Danny attended school in the Fort Hall area and graduated from Blackfoot High school in 1971. While in high school he was active in the Rodeo Club, FFA and Indian Club.

On June 25, 1971 Danny married his high school sweetheart, Gwenevier L. Dixey. On March 1, 1972 they welcomed their first daughter, Wendy Lee Eagle. On October 30, 1975 their second daughter Colista Lynn Eagle was born. Danny and Gwen were later divorced.

Danny was a horse shoer by trade, but did other jobs as a heavy equipment operator, laborer and even a police officer. Danny was an enrolled member of the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes and lived most of his life in the Fort Hall area with the exception of the times that he resided in Riverton, Wyoming.

He is survived by his daughters, Wendy L. Eagle, of Fort Hall; Colista (Kidd) Eagle-Farmer, of Pocatello; companion, Sharon Frasure, of Malad, ID; mother, Ella Sambo Appenay, sister, Mary Ann Appenay, brother Morgan Poog, all of Fort Hall, nephews Logan Eagle and James Perry; grandchildren Lailoni Eagle, Ueliyas and Cohl Redwoman.

He was preceded in death by his father Paul Eagle and adopted parents, Homer and Nell Cutler, two brothers, Melvin Poog and Cordel Eagle.
