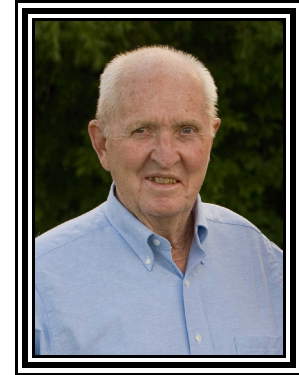


## Obituary

### Kay Simpson Jorgensen, 81



Kay Simpson Jorgensen, 81, of Pleasant Grove, Utah and formerly of Moreland, Idaho, passed away Tuesday, August 17, 2010 at his home.

He was born May 25, 1929 in Moreland, to Leeman Artgar and Mary Simpson Jorgensen.

He was raised and attended school in Moreland, graduating from Moreland High School. He earned a Bachelor's Degree in accounting and received his teaching certificate from Idaho State University.

Kay served two years in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict, stationed in Germany.

On August 26, 1955 he married Rozilla Berrett in the Idaho Falls LDS Temple. They made their home in Moreland and raised their family there. Kay has lived most of his life in the Blackfoot area, he has lived the last few years in Utah.

He was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and has served as High Priest Group Leader, Gospel Doctrine Teacher, temple worker, fulfilled a mission to the Charleston West Virginia Mission, and has also worked in the name extraction program, extracting over 20,000 names last year.

Kay farmed and taught English at Blackfoot Jr. High School for 10 years. He enjoyed raising his cattle, fishing, hunting, gardening and raising roses. He loved times spent with his family.

He is survived by his wife, Rozilla, of Pleasant Grove, Utah; his children: Jill Jorgensen, of Blackfoot, Paul Barton (Cindi) Jorgensen, of Hermisten, Oregon, Katherine (Merlin) David, of Pallos Verdes, California, Shawn K (Karen) Jorgensen, of Willard, Utah, Mitchell (Vanessa) Jorgensen, of Pleasant Grove, Utah; one brother, Dee (LaRee) Jorgensen, of Blackfoot; two sisters, Rebecca Green, of McCammon, Donna (Bill) Neilson, of Sandy, Utah; fifteen grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one infant brother, three sisters, June Grimmert, Bessie Cutforth, Virginia Harris and two infant sisters.

Funeral service will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday, August 21, 2010 at the Moreland LDS Chapel with Bishop Rob Wray conducting.
