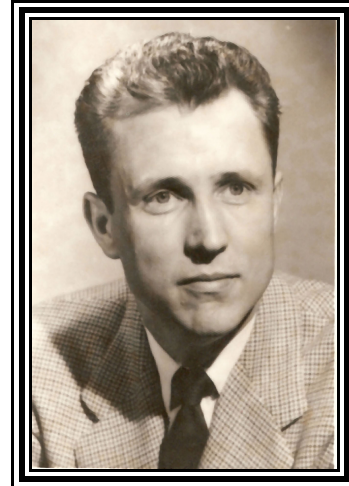


Obituary

Arthur Ray Lambson, 82, of Oceanside, California, passed away February 17, 2010 at his home after an extended illness.
