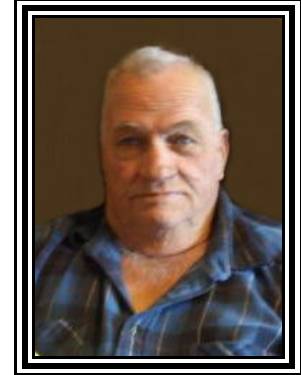


Obituary
