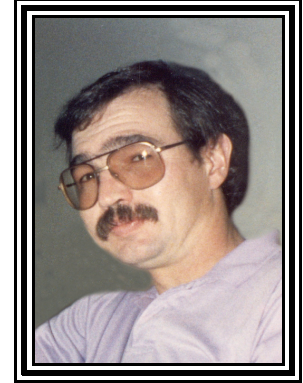


## Obituary
