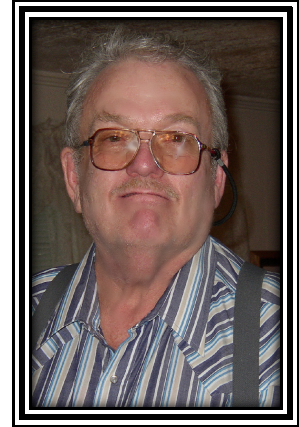


Obituary

Blaine Lloyd, 70



Blaine Lloyd, 70, our Brother, Uncle and Friend, of Blackfoot, Idaho, passed away on August 29, 2010. Blaine was born to William Earl Lloyd and Eva Weeks on April 22, 1940 in Dayton, Idaho. Blaine grew up with four brothers and three sisters.

As a young boy, Blaine worked on the farm with his family. As his Dad would hoe the beet row, Arves and Blaine would go behind and thin the beets. He also helped with harvesting and hauling the hay. After the older brothers and sisters moved away, Blaine and Gloria helped with milking the cows and taking care of the other animals. He had a very easygoing personality except when one of his siblings made him really mad. Blaine also helped in the house with his Mother and his sisters. He was always kind to them.

Blaine graduated from Seminary on May 23, 1957 and from West Side High School in Dayton, Idaho on May 28, 1958.

Blaine worked with his brother Arves, one summer, at the Blackfoot Indian Reservation. He lived in Utah for a time and worked as a block and brick mason tender. Then while staying with his sister Neva, he worked at a Farm in Providence, Utah for 3 years. Blaine eventually went back to Idaho and worked at a potato starch plant in Blackfoot and was a custodian for many years at Stan's Café. Blaine worked with his brother, Leonard, helping him at his dairy farm for many years. He volunteered at the Church farm in Dayton where everyone really appreciated Blaine as he was very conscientious with the farm machines and the equipment.

Blaine was very kind to his Mother and helped her in her later years to make sure that she was okay and comfortable.

Blaine was a much deeper thinker than a lot of people gave him credit for. He knew a lot about life. He was a very private person, keeping his problems to himself and not wanting to burden others. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints.

A few words that best describe Blaine are: Steady, shy, sweet, gentle, and honest.

Blaine is survived by one sister, Neva (Robert) Pead or St. George, Utah and by three brothers. Doyle (Shirley) Lloyd of Kaysville, Utah, Leon Lloyd of Blackfoot, Idaho and Arves (Loma) Lloyd of Malad, Idaho (Arves and Loma are currently serving a mission for the LDS church in Beattyville, Kentucky).

Blaine is preceded in death by his sisters, LaRee Leota Gardner, Gloria Gay Lloyd and his brother, Leonard Lloyd, his niece Susan Gardner Wright and his Parents William Earl Lloyd and Eva Weeks Lloyd.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m., Thursday September 2, 2010 at Hawker Funeral Home, 132 South Shilling in Blackfoot.
