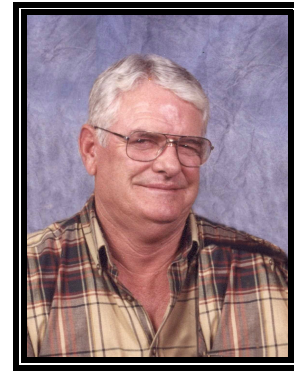


# Obituary
