Antonio C. Longoria, 60, of Blackfoot, Idaho passed away Saturday, June 18, 2011.

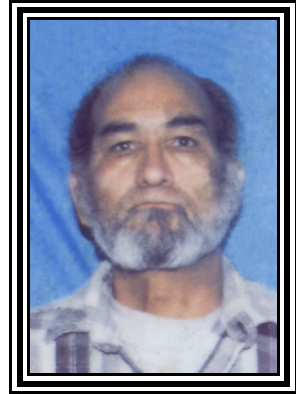
