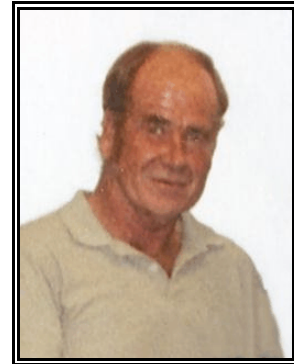


Obituary
