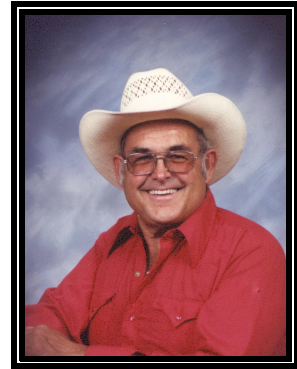


## Obituary
