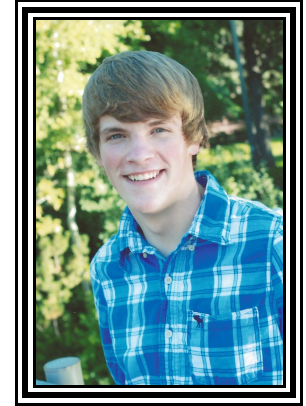


# Obituary
