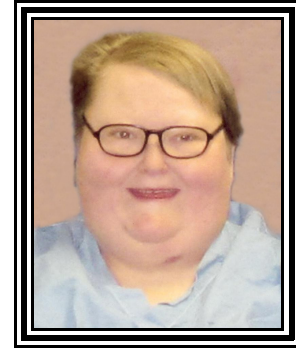


## Obituary
