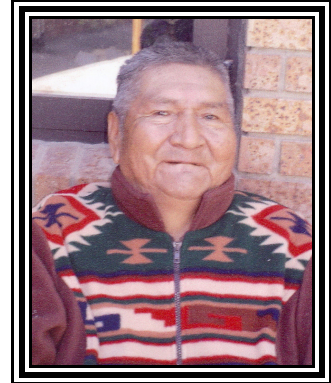


## Obituary
