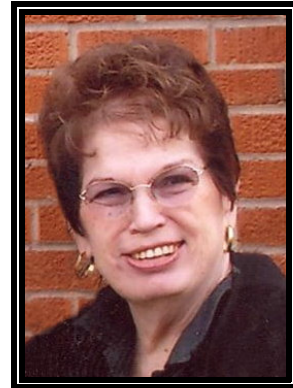


OBITUARY
