Syble Harris Tyler, 90, of Blackfoot, Idaho, passed away Thursday, March 25, 2010 at her daughter's home from natural causes.

Syble was born March 10, 1920 in Mink Creek, Idaho to Larets Walter Nelson and Lula Violet Olsen Nelson. She spent her childhood and attended school in Mink Creek, until moving to Thatcher, where she completed her education, graduating in May of 1938 and getting married in October of 1938.

On October 5, 1938, Syble married Gerald Harris in the Salt Lake LDS Temple. Together they had three children, Michael, Patricia and Gloria.

Syble and Gerald lived on the family farm in Thatcher until 1978. At that time, they traded homes with their son and moved to Grace, Idaho. On November 9, 2002, Syble married Stuart Charles Tyler in Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Syble worked as a grocery clerk in Nider and Fowler's supermarket in Soda Springs. In her free time, she enjoyed quilting, crocheting and knitting. She was a great cook, homemaker and seamstress. She loved music, to fish, play Pinochle and she taught and helped in 4-H.

Syble was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. She served as a temple officiator in the Logan LDS Temple, taught in Relief Society, was president of the Primary and Young Women organizations, and was active in the drama and road shows in the Thatcher area.
