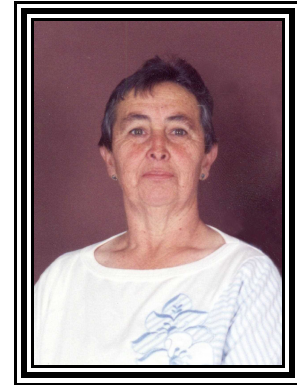


# Obituary
