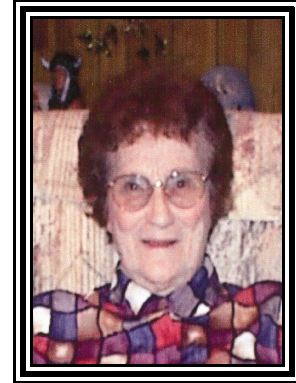


**OBITUARY**
