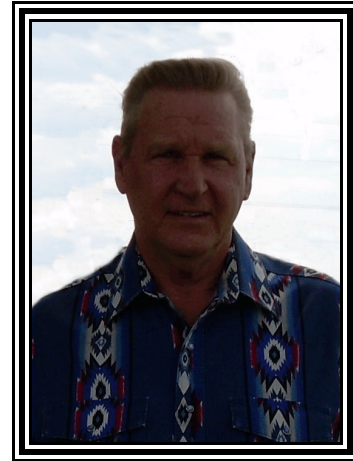


# Obituary

## Norman “Norm” Wilson, 58



Norman Wilson, 58, of Blackfoot, passed away Saturday, January 3, 2009 at his home following an extended illness.
