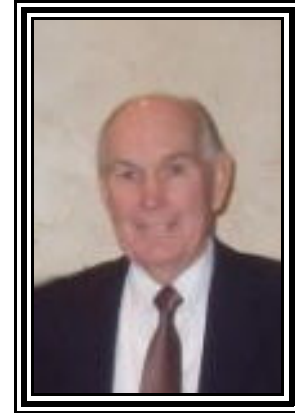


Obituary

Kenneth L. Young, 74 year old Blackfoot resident, died Sunday, March 27, 2011, in Blackfoot, following an illness.
