LaRue Ardell Jackman Mathie, age 95, formerly of Blackfoot, Idaho, passed away at Rocky Mountain Care Center in Clearfield, Utah on Friday, May 28, 2010 from causes incident to age.



She was born July 23, 1914 in Blackfoot, Idaho to Walter Brady and Martha Gardner Jackman.
